How to Create a DVD with Encore – Oct 26th 2011

You will need:

A computer with Encore Installed A video in a standard format A blank DVD Basic Computer Proficiency

- 1. Start Encore on your Computer
- 2. A start screen will appear. Choose New Project.
- 3. Enter a name for your project
- 4. Choose a location for your project to be saved
- 5. Set Authoring Mode to DVD and Television Standard to NTSC
- 6. Click OK
- 7. Set and reset the default layout.
 - a. This guide follows the default layout.
 - b. Select Window>Workspace>Default
 - c. Select Window>Workspace>Reset "default" ...
- 8. The top left panel should now be your Project window
- 9. Import your File
 - a. Go to File>Import As>Timeline...
 - b. Navigate to and select your video
 - c. Click Open
- 10. A timeline and a video file should now appear in your project window
- 11. Switch to the Timelines tab near the tab for the Project window
- 12. Select the timeline you see there
- 13. Confirm that it is set as first play
 - a. Right-Click on it
 - b. If the timeline is not set as first play you will have the option to "Set as First Play"
 - c. If the timeline **is set** as first play you will have the option to "Clear First Play"
- 14. A Properties window will have changed on the right side of the screen
- 15. Find the end action property and change it to "stop"
- 16. Now deselect the timeline in the timelines window
- 17. The properties panel will have changed again
- 18. Find the Property "Title Button:" and set it to "stop"
- 19. Locate the Build Window
 - a. Its tab is located next to the timelines tab
- 20. You may not see the entire window due to monitor size
- 21. Maximize this window by hitting the ~ key
 - a. The \sim key is located to the left of the 1 on your keyboard.
 - b. No need to use shift. ~ is easier to spot than `
 - c. Relax. This is a toggle function and can be reversed by hitting the key again
- 22. From Top to Bottom

- a. Confirm that the format is DVD
- b. Confirm that the output is DVD Disc
- c. The destination is the drive with your blank DVD
- d. Name Your Project
- e. Size should be 4.7GB
- f. Side should be 1
- g. Regions should be all
- h. CGMS should be "Unlimited copies are allowed"
- 23. Return to the top
- 24. Near the top right should be a check project button
 - a. Press it
 - b. This brings up a new window
 - c. Press the start button in the new window
 - d. If anything shows up, read through this guide again to see if you missed anything
 - e. Selecting any errors will bring the tab where the fix is required to the top of its window
 - f. Be sure to un-maximize your build menu so you can see the results
 - g. If nothing shows up you can close the window
- 25. Back in the Build window
 - a. Look for the build button in the top right.
 - b. Press it
 - c. Encore will now encode and then burn your video to the disc
 - d. When it is finished the DVD will pop out of the drive.
- 26. Be sure to label your new disc
